It is based on some relevant resources concerning theoretical approaches to transformation processes and on the most recent empirical material presenting the dynamics of attitudes of the Polish society towards particular examples of change. It will give students the knowledge of basic transformation processes in the post-socialist society. It will help them develop abilities to use various sociological empirical material (e.g. public opinion studies reports and other secondary data) and acquire sociological imagination necessary to understand mechanisms of social change. 14.
